- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 2 weeks (D AUGSBUR01), within 4 weeks, provided the documents are complete (HR OSIJEK01).
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 4 weeks (HR OSIJEK01), no late than 5 weeks (D AUGSBUR01) after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

The institutions decide in mutual agreement on the procedure of modifying or terminating the agreement. In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year has to be given.

Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
