UNIOS provides technical and academic support to students and staff with disabilities; depending on individual needs, excluding financial supports.

A LINZ11: If you wish to take part in a language course "German for foreigners", the courses run by the Johannes-Kepler-University of Linz are open to you free of charge. In particular, the Petrinum hostel is not far from the KUL and would be convenient for you. As the KUL is a small university, we do not organize an introductory event for new arrivals. 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks, provided the documents are complete.

- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 4 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

The institutions decide in mutual agreement on the procedure of modifying or terminating the agreement. In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year has to be given.
