D. Additional requirements

HR OSIJEKO1: UNIOS cannot accept applications received after the stated deadline. It is not possible for students to defend Bachelor papers, Master thesis or PhD thesis at UNIOS within this agreement and to obtain final qualification. UNIOS provides technical and academic support to students and staff with disabilities; depending on individual needs, excluding financial supports.

PL POZNANO1: Before sending formal applications, students must be officially nominated by their home universities. Application documents received after application deadlines will not be accepted. In case, if the application documents aren't in Polish or English language, the applicants have to add the authorized translation of these documents. Exchange studies for PhD students are organized according to individual plans. It is not possible for exchange students to defend their BA/MA/PhD thesis at the host university. Incoming international staff members should apply for visits to the departmental coordinators of the respective faculty (http://unipo.sk/en/en/internationa-relations/staffmobility). Applicants with special needs will be contacted before the final approval of the acceptance. Final decision depends on extra services/ facilities available. AMU provides technical and academic support to students and staff with disabilities; depending on individual needs, excluding financial supports.
